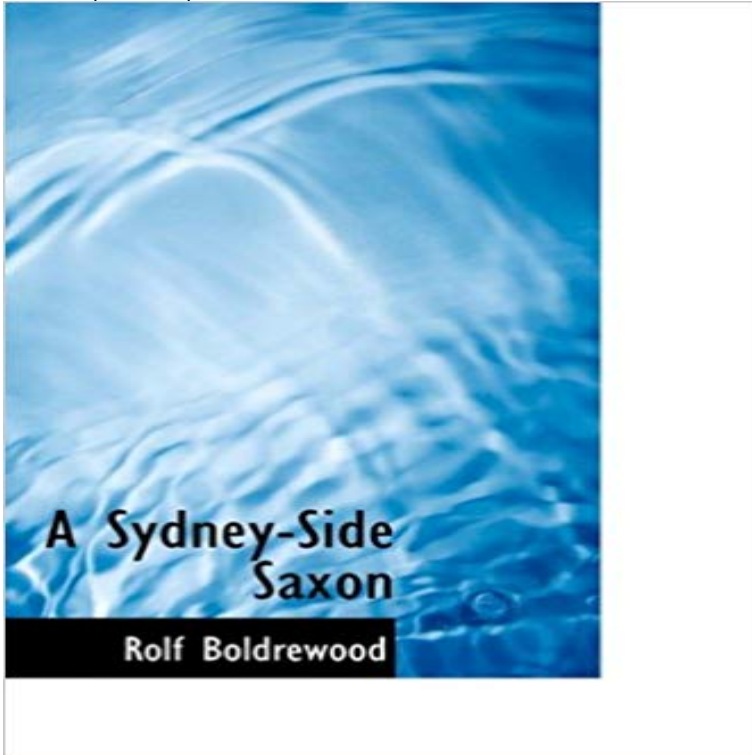


# A Sydney-Side Saxon
