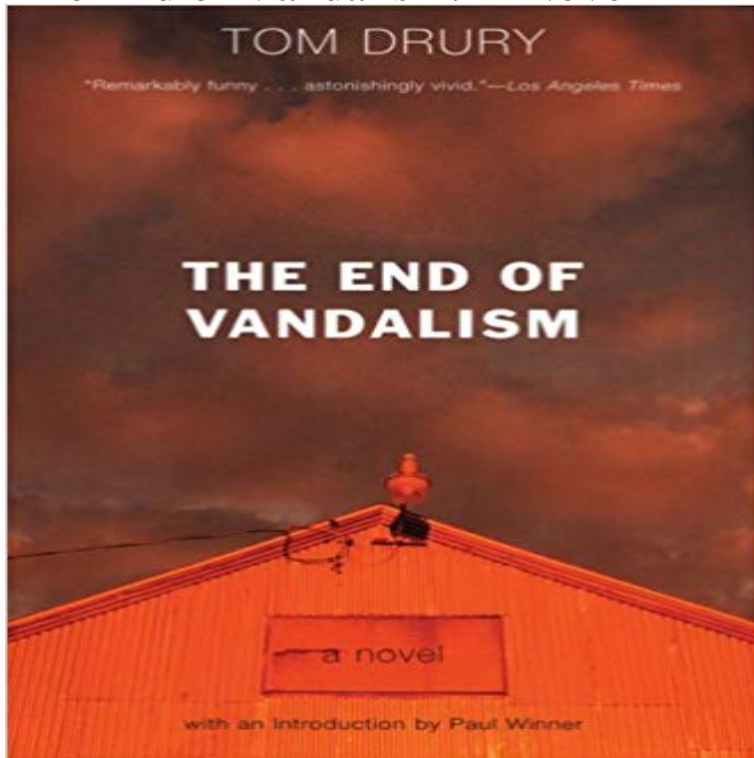


The End of Vandalism: A Novel
